## Finance Committee Report - Ken Contrera

- In the next couple of years, the Diocese of Cleveland will be changing the structure of the assessment for each parish. In the past it has been a level structure for all parishes, (same percentage of the basket for all parishes) but going forward it will be on a sliding scale and could be as much as 20% of the basket for larger parishes. They will also implement a change in the assessment per student for all parish schools.
- The seminarians will be leaving our parish in a few weeks.
- Fr. Marcelli will only be here for two years.
- The greenhouse project is coming along. The inground base is now complete. The greenhouse will be made to look like the other buildings on the property when completed.
- The Elmdale house is being cleaned, painted and made ready for its future purpose.
- The lamp posts will be in by the end of August.
- The school financials for the FYE 2024 are in process. Things are looking good for FYE 2023-2024.
- The 2024-25 school year looks good. Currently 337 students are enrolled (capacity and a waiting list for pre-school). Improvements are being made to the processing of EdChoice applications for the school. We are currently still waiting on over 100 students' EdChoice applications. We are aggressively pursuing these applications and will inform parents that if we don't receive your application, you will be billed for the full amount of the tuition.
- The Finance Committee will not meet in August. Next meeting on September 26.

This person would lead the contemporary ensemble and be primary musician for 11:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday. Depending on the individual skills of the applicant, there is a possibility for the position responsibilities to be expanded. Have posted/advertised the position with the diocese, in church bulletins and several online venues. The response has been less than I would have anticipated.</li> </ul>			
	Music Arts Series is planned with eleven events for the 2024/2025 season. Plan to have initial publicity go out to the parish and community the first week in August. Will also start a series benefactor program where people may contribute to the Musical Arts Series, ultimately allowing the series to grow and be self-sustainable. Contributors will be recognized in the event programs and will be placed in a database. Also would like to establish a Musical Arts mailing list as to have another way of publicizing events.			
	I have discovered that a significant percentage of our music library contains photocopied music, which can be a potential liability. Working on replacing the photocopies with printed copies. This will be an extensive and expensive undertaking. Currently exploring different options for funding in addition to what is budgeted in the general fund.			
	Have recruited over June and July for cantors with three people showing interest. In August my recruitment will shift to focus on recruiting choristers.
