Father's Update

- Greenhouse almost finished. Waiting for final inspections from city which are expected this week

- Cleveland Diocese is reassessing parishes for 2025. St. Sebastian rate expected to increase. Cost per student fee to the Diocese also expected to increase.
- Urgent requests to the parish are increasing. Request to parishioners: Allow time to Father and staff to reflect. Even simple requests are often more complicated in nature.
- New Ministry to be considered. Adopting elderly in Summit county area and becoming an advocate.
 There is a great need for this ministry and there are approximately 3,000 in Summit county who could use this service.
